Financial Assistance for the Preservation and Development of Cultural Heritage of Himalayas.

Ministry of Culture, invites applications in the prescribed format under the Scheme of Financial Assistance for the Preservation and Development of Cultural Heritage of Himalayas for the year 2012-13 from Voluntary Organizations/Institutions/Trusts engaged in the field of promotion, protection and preservation of Cultural Heritage of Himalayas for undertaking the activities for Preservation and Development of Cultural Heritage of Himalayas in the States falling under the Himalayan Region i.e. Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Sikkim and Arunachal Pradesh.

2. Financial assistance may be given for all or any of the items listed in the scheme upto a maximum of Rs. 10.00 lakhs per year for any single organization. The Expert Advisory Committee (EAC) on the scheme is empowered to recommend or reject any proposal and also to recommend the amount beyond the maximum limit but not exceeding Rs. 30.00 lacs from this scheme, in respect of any proposal which is of outstanding merit for which the EAC feels that the maximum limit would not be sufficient for undertaking the said project, with the approval of Minister (Culture) and concurrence of AS & FA, Ministry of Culture.

3. The maximum grant admissible to an organization would be 75% of the total expenditure to be incurred on any item subject to maximum ceiling fixed. The remaining 25% expenditure or more should be met by the State Govt./U.T. Administration failing which the grantee organisation could contribute the amount from their own resources. However, in the case of North-Eastern State and Sikkim, funding will be shared between the Government of India and the state Government in the ratio of 90:10 respectively failing which the grantee organization could contribute from their own resources.

4. The organisation shall submit complete application alongwith the required documents/information to judge the eligibility of the organization through the State Government where the project is to be implemented. The organisation, however, located in North Eastern States, Sikkim, Leh and Kargil districts of Jammu & Kashmir may submit their applications direct to Ministry of Culture with the recommendation of District Collector/Dy. Commissioner where the project is to be implemented. The recommending authority will ensure compliance to para 4.2 of the scheme.

5. The organisation shall also submit the requisite documents such as (i) Bond, (ii) Resolution, (iii) Bank Authorization Letter and (iv) Agency registration form alongwith the application form.

6. The Organization against which previous Grant/Utilisation Certificate under this scheme is pending will not be considered for fresh grant. Applications received from such organisations against which previous Grant/UC under this scheme is pending are liable to be rejected.

7. The application in the prescribed format complete in all respect, duly spiral bound and continuously page numbered, alongwith check-list duly recommended should reach the Under Secretary, BTI Section, Ministry of Culture, NAI Annexe Building, Janpath, New Delhi.
