

## Integrity Pact

**(Duly Notarised affidavit on Non- Judicial Stamp paper of Rs.100 (Rupees Hundred only)**

### INTEGRITY AND ETHICS UNDERTAKING

[Name of the bidder] Undertakes to act in good faith with respect to one and others to one and others rights prior to, during or subsequent to the currency of the contract and to adopt all responsible measures to ensure the realization of the objectives prior to, during or subsequent to the currency of the contract Integrity and Ethics.

[Name of the bidder] undertakes to avoid all forms of corruption by following a system that is fair, transparent and free from influence and prejudice, prior to, during or subsequent to the currency of the contract.

[Name of the bidder] commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corrupt practice, unfair means and illegal activities during any stages of its bid or during any pre-contract or post-contract stage in order to secure the contract or in furtherance to secure it.

Ministry of Culture undertakes that during the pre-contract stage, it shall treat all bidders alike and will provide to all bidders the same information and will not provide any such information to any particular bidder which could afford an advantage to any particular bidder in comparison to other bidders. Any breach of aforesaid provisions by [Name of the bidder] or its employees or authorized representatives, shall entitle Ministry of Culture to take all or any one of the following actions, wherever required:-

- i. forfeiture of performance guarantee.
- ii. to immediately call-off the pre-contract negotiations without assigning any reason or providing any compensation to [Name of the bidder].
- iii. to debar [Name of the bidder] from participating in any bidding process in future for a minimum period of 5 years.
- iv. to cancel all or any other contract signed with [Name of the bidder].

Ministry of Culture will be entitled to initiate the criminal liabilities as well.
